Transport from airport to Bewley's hotel



With a few exceptions all IP and conference professors are lodged at the Beweley's Ballsbridge hotel in Southeast Dublin, cf.

<http://www.bewleyshotels.com/ballsbridge>.

The best way to get there from the airport is the AIRCOACH bus. Once you come out through the 'exit doors' at the airport, you will see the bus sign as you walk out slightly left. As you exit the building, look out for the **Aircoach bus to Ballsbridg**.

Buy a roundtrip ticket for Euro 15.00 and keep it for your return. Once on the bus it takes about half an hour to get through the city to the Southeast of Dublin and to Bewley's hotel. Get off at the "**Bewley's hotel** / Simonscourt Road" stop. Don't get nervous, the driver will announce the stop in time (for your help you may want to print off the attached aircoach bus **route map**). The buses run 24 hours, though less frequent after midnight. Note: It is not worth it to take a taxi (around Euro 30-40); such makes sense only if it is two or three of you travelling together.

Venue of Intensive Programme / Conference

The 2-week Intensive Programme is carried out in two locations.

June 14 and 15, Milltown Institute in Milltown Park, South Dublin, next door to the Irish School of Ecumenics. For a google map about the location, see:

June 16 to 18, Trinity College, Arts Building (Upper Concourse; Syge Theatre)

June 21 to 25, Milltown Institute in Milltown Park, South Dublin.

Transports to Intensive Programme / Conference Venue from accommodation (or the city centre)

Taxi-Transport from Bewley's hotel to venues of Intensive Programme (Milltown Park, June 14 and 15; June 21 to 25) or Conference Programme (Trinity College, June 16 to 18)



In order to get you timely to the programme in the morning, we will organise taxis at the hotel which bring you to the Intensive Programme / Conference site on time. You need to register for the taxi the night before at the hotel registration area. At the end of each day of programme held at Milltown Park, taxis will you also bring back to the hotel, unless you want to go into town by regular public buses.

At the end of each day of programme held at Trinity College, you can take bus no. 7 from Trinity College Gate (exit Nassau Street), which stops right at the hotel. Alternatively, you may also want to take the DART train from "Pearse Street" (at the back entrance of Trinity) to "Sandymount" station and walk five minutes from there to the hotel.



To Milltown Institute / ISE via Dublin Bus

Nos. 11, 11A, and 11B from Trinity College Gate and Nos. 44, 44B, and 48 on Townsend Street adjacent to Screen Cinema. After the Esso Petrol Station, get off at the next bus stop. Cross the street and enter the front entrance to Milltown Park. Walk up the long driveway and ISE is the first building on the right. Bus rides are normally 20-25 minutes from city centre depending on traffic.
