



## STUDENT RESEARCH PRESENTATIONS

All participants will be presenting distinct research work during one of the parallel “Research Presentation” sessions at the IP. We advise students to either draw on chapters of their PhD dissertation or their Master thesis. Or to pursue a distinct new research for the IP.

In both cases, participants shall try to **link their topic to one of the themes** listed below.

  - New Democracies in Southeast Europe
  - Constructing Religious Identities
  - Constructing [O]rthodoxy
  - Inhabiting a (Post) Secular Age
  - Southeast Europe’s Religions and the EU
  - Fluid Religions and New Modernity
  - Religion and Globalisation
  - The Study of Religions in a Changing Europe
  - Engaging the Other: Interreligious Historical and Comparative Theological Explorations
  - Shared Religious Sites and Spaces
  - Religion and Power in Interreligious Settings

There is a further two-fold preparatory process to it.

1. All participants must submit an **essay** of their research (15-20 pages; Times New Roman 12, pt, 1.5 space) no later than **June 1, 2012** by email to [translating.gods@tcd.ie](mailto:translating.gods@tcd.ie).
  2. After submission of the essay participants prepare a separate **presentation** of 20 minutes of their research elaborated in the essay. Clearly this needs a 2<sup>nd</sup> step of preparation and try-outs in advance, before presenting at the IP. Participants will be informed of the exact day of their presentation in August.
